2016 - 2017

- 1) Improve communication with the District community, including parents, students and staff, regarding issues such as the status of implementation of Common Core standards and the District Implementation Plan, and issues on the BOE agenda.
- 2) Identify and communicate to the District community student achievement results using common State and regional assessments and measures monitoring student achievement compared to similar schools regionally and Statewide. For assessments where students are currently scoring in the top quartile, strive to improve the mastery rate by 2% annually, and for assessments and exams where students are currently performing below the top quartile, strive to improve the rate by 3% annually.
- 3) Increase mental and physical well-being of student/District population
- 4) Improve both college and career readiness of graduates
- 5) Ensure sound fiscal management of the district, exploring shared serve opportunities as a means of maintaining quality educational programming.
- 6) Identify strategies that encourage and increase student participation in the fine arts (Art, Music, and Drama) and Language Other Than English
